### **Museum Store:**

The original Museum Store of The Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza presents a broad selection of books, media, replica jewelry and educational gifts for all ages related to President John F. Kennedy's life, death and legacy, as well as presidential, American and regional history. The store is located inside the Museum at 411 Elm Street and is open during regular Museum hours.

### **Museum Store + Café:**

The Museum Store + Café is located in the historic 501 Elm building across the street from the Museum. Overlooking Dealey Plaza, the Store + Café welcomes Museum guests and local residents with an ever-changing mix of unique offerings in a contemporary yet historic setting. This AIA award-winning space gives visitors a more complete site experience to the National Historic Landmark and The Sixth Floor Museum exhibits.

With a focus on President Kennedy's legacy and Dallas culture and history, the Museum Store + Café showcases newly published books and documentaries, works by local artisans, and special gift items including distinctive pop culture products inspired by the 1960s. A selection of freshly brewed coffees and teas, smoothies, frozen yogurt, sandwiches and snacks can be found in the Café.
