What to do:


- Make notes about what the investigators said and did during the investigation.



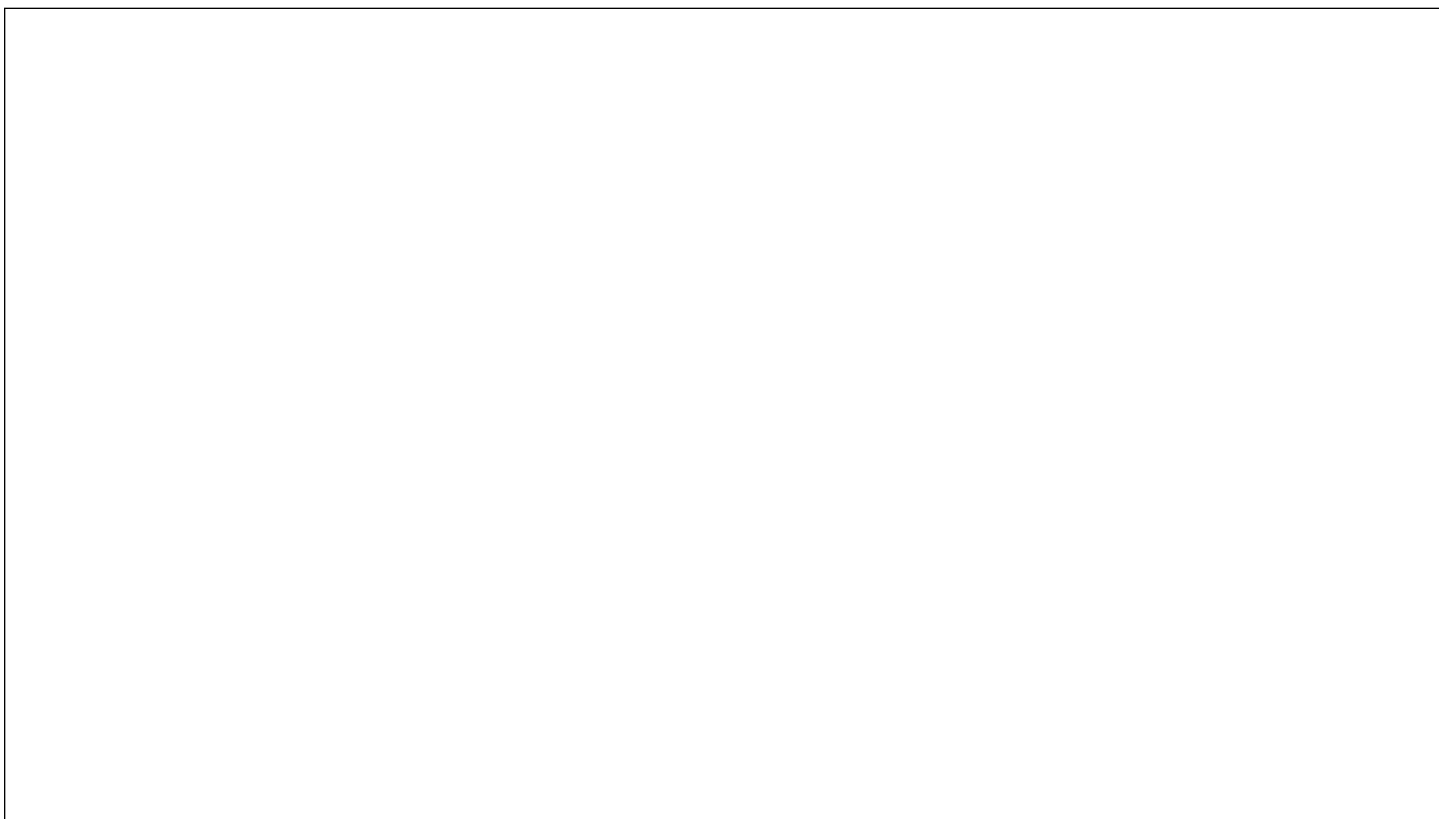
1. Characteristics of the Texas School Book Depository and surrounding location

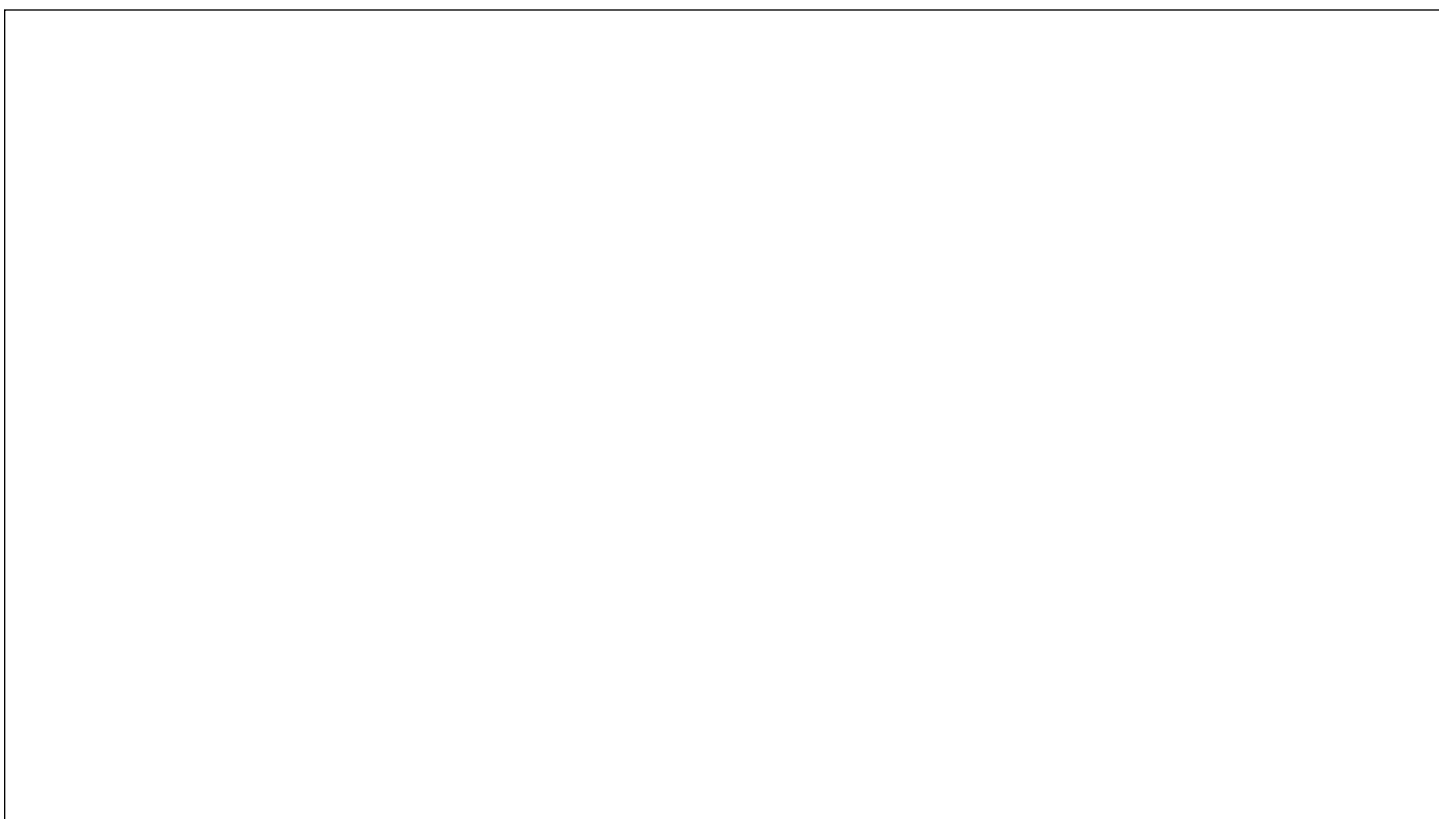
2. Preservation of fingerprints
